Downtown Design Program by Volunteer Architects from the Iowa Architect Foundation

- The City now has the drawings with the streetscaping and beautification improvements, including recommendations for colors and themes, parking improvements and green space, for downtown Carlisle.
- Downtown building façade improvements are recommended to improve appearance, continuity and theme.
- The design improvements will transform the downtown community and enhance flow for street, pedestrian and bike traffic.

Community Visioning Program

- Approximately 65 people will participate in the Focus Groups on Saturday, March 5, and step through a research project managed by Iowa State University and Trees Forever to determine needed transportation enhancements throughout the city.
- With cameras in hand, participants will take pictures of areas that need improvement or that already work well. This information will be compiled with results from citizen surveys and discussions to guide landscape architects in making suggestions for improvement projects in Carlisle.
- An unveiling of suggested projects will be held at a public event in the Fall. Grants will be sought to fund selected projects.

The PEACH Affair

Carlisle Area Dollars for Scholars was founded in 1998 by Alan and Melinda Huisinga who worked with local leaders, and the Iowa affiliate of Scholarship America, to establish a Carlisle area chapter. The chapter is often referred to as the PEACH chapter in representation of the Palmyra, Easter Lake, Avon, Carlisle, and Hartford areas served by the Carlisle Community School District.

After creating a board of community spirited members, the Huisinga's established the chapter's first endowment scholarship in memory of their son Chad.

The 2016 Event will be on April 2, 2016.

In 2015 the Carlisle Area Dollars for Scholars board awarded 105 graduating seniors a total of \$46,450.

Since it's establishment in 1998, the Carlisle Area Dollars for Scholars board has awarded CHS seniors with 1171 scholarships worth \$587,200!


