- Public Measure C passed to upgrade the Carlisle Fire Station located at 136 N. 2<sup>nd</sup> to better serve the area's growing population. Instead of a new building or a remodeled warehouse, this option allows up to \$600,000 towards improvements to the existing fire department.
- New bay for firetruck
- 2<sup>nd</sup> floor addition with space for small bunkhouse, showers and new kitchen. By bunking at the station, volunteers who generally travel a long distance will be immediately available to respond to calls.
- Expanded office in place of current kitchen




# Once Again, PumpkinFest was a HIT!




