



## **Recap of August Chamber Meeting:** Policy for Tobacco and Nicotine Free worksites

- A tobacco and nicotine free worksite policy is an extension to the lowa Smoke free Air Act that prohibits all tobacco use (including electronic cigarettes) on company property.
- Research has shown that electronic cigarettes and other electronic smoking devices can contain heavy metals, toxins, and cancer causing agents. Tobacco use is costly to employers and is the #1 cause of preventable death and disease.
- Tobacco and nicotine free worksite policies are an important policy update for businesses to protect the health and safety of their employees and customers.

The American Lung Association is a community resource to help worksites update their policies. Many worksites in the area have updated their policies and we encourage you to reach out to the American Lung Association for assistance. The American Lung Association can provide free resources, signage, and other incentives to businesses who update their policies. We work with businesses to help draft a policy that is best for them. - Maintain all ball fields, batting cages, and building /concession area throughout the year



- City-owned mowing & general maintenance of park provided
- Current fields are in great shape due to investments made by CLL/CGSA

- Limited parking/Condition of parking
