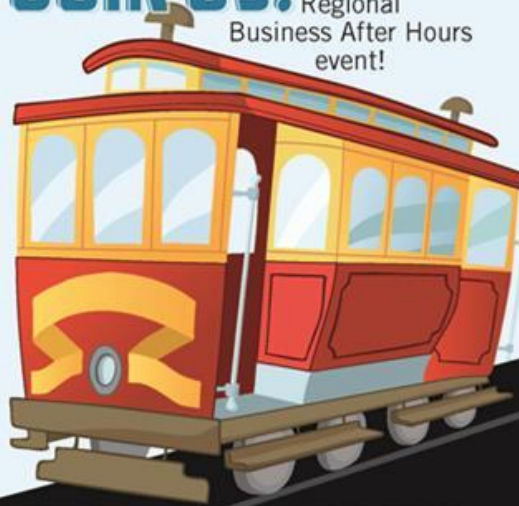

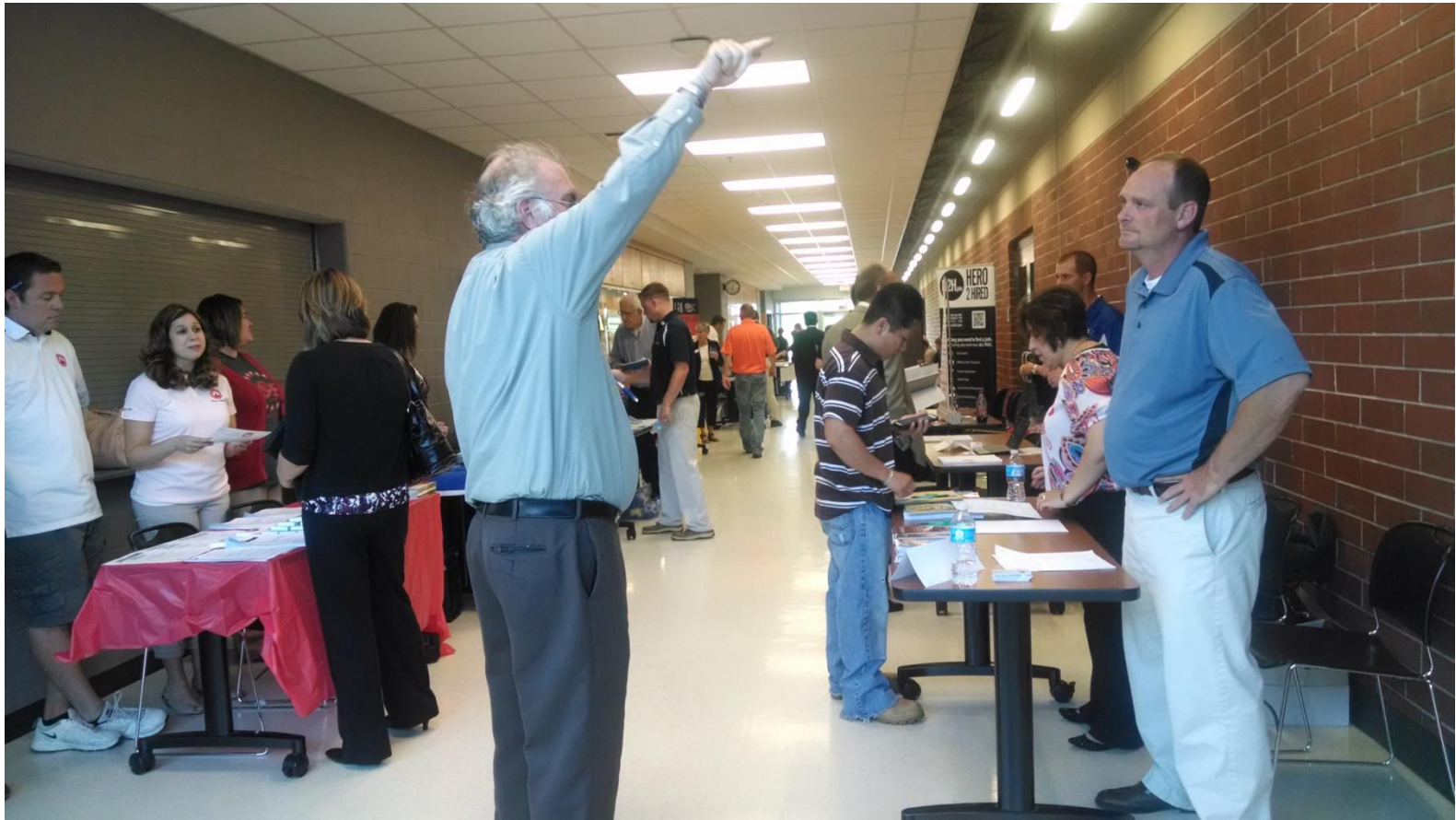
# Warren County Career Fair
