SHAKESPERIENCE FEST 2011

A FREE outdoor summer theatre program Funded by Bravo Greater Des Moines, Prairie Meadows, and the Iowa Arts Council

ABOUT SHAKESPERIENCE FEST: Shakesperience Fest is a FREE outdoor program of classic theatre "under-the-stars" that is provided by the Des Moines non-profit called The Iowa Shakespeare Experience. 


