### CARLISLE COMMUNITY SCHOOL - HARTFORD FACILITY

A Ribbon Cutting ceremony recently followed an Open House to celebrate the newly updated Carlisle School Facility in Hartford. Since the summer of 2009, \$2.9 million of renovations and additions have been added to the Hartford Upper Elementary. This included 38,342 square feet of renovated space and an addition of 8,000 square feet. All of these changes were made possible by the State-wide one cent sales tax recently passed.

In addition, the PTO, headed by Jen Rowray, was instrumental in a fundraising project for the addition of the new playground equipment behind the school building. Over \$57,000 was raised. Volunteers helped to erect this equipment to add the much needed playground for the children.

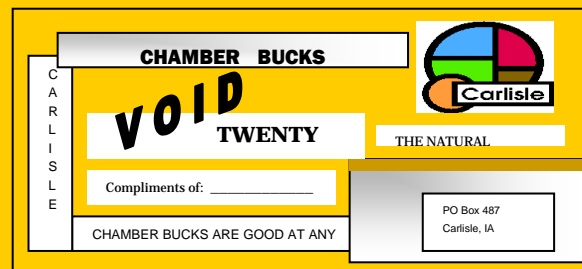

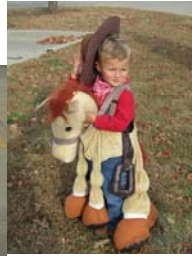
