9-11 a.m. – Kids Hope USA Mentors and student volunteers

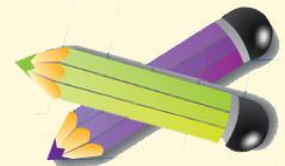
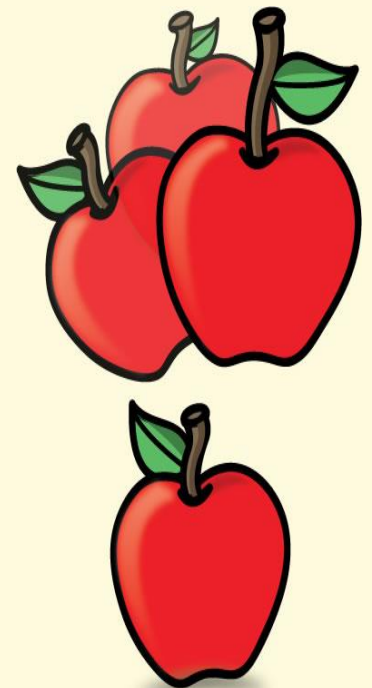
12-2 p.m. – Community & School Volunteers
