& Stadium View for continuing to partner with the Chamber to offer this wonderful networking opportunity for our members and the community.












SUMMERSET TRAIL



We invite you to explore Summerset Trail either by bicycle or on foot. You'll find an enjoyable trail that passes through prairie, wetlands, woodlands and along the Middle River southwest of Carlisle. Enjoy nature, wildlife, fitness and family fun!

Summerset Trail is 11 miles long and is paved with asphalt. It is a "rail Trail" having been built on the route of an abandoned railroad line between Carlisle at it's northeast end and Indianola at the southwest end. The Summerset Trail is a "National Recreation Trail (NRT).

The trailhead at Carlisle provides parking, portable toilets, and a shelter and picnic area.




