

Q: WHEN WAS THE CURRENT LIBRARY BUILT?

43 years ago in 1981

Q: WILL THE BOND RAISE MY TAXES?

No. Carlisle city officials have leveraged our debt service levy through bonding and cash management to keep the debt service levy stable at \$4.50 / \$1,000 in valuation.

Q: WHY DO WE NEED TO EXPAND THE LIBRARY?

- · 40% population growth for Carlisle since 1980
- 30,000+ annual visits to the facility
- 240+ programs are held at the library and after hours. With a larger space, all programs will be held at the library.

Q: HOW WAS THE SIZE DETERMINED?

Size was determined by the identified space needs for a community our size, as well as the increase of program attendees.

Q: WHY IS MORE BOOK SPACE NEEDED?

Currently, the children's bookshelves are at capacity. Our hope is to have additional space to increase material offerings and decrease wait time for inter-library loans.

Q: WHY IS THE LIBRARY BEING MOVED ACROSS THE HIGHWAY?

Two reasons:

- The City already owned a building-the recreation center-that could be remodeled, including increasing the size through an addition.
- The population of the City has increased and shifted to south of the highway (2019: North Hwy 5 – 30%, South of Hwy 5 – 43.20%, Rural – 26.3%).



Q: WHY IS A NEW AND RENOVATED LIBRARY ESSENTIAL TO THE CARLISLE COMMUNITY?

- Increased rentable space for community to hold events, after hours without library staff needing to be onsite
- Extended partnerships with the Chamber and Lunch & Learn opportunities
- Provide community hub with space for people to gather for cards, socials, coffee, and other offerings
- · Great location near the pool and walking trails

In 2020, Carlisle's City officials began the 7 in 7 Plan that would tackle 7 major building or infrastructure projects in 7 years. The proposed library facility project is the last of the 7 projects. A bond vote gives Council the authority to use part of the debt service to fund the proposed library project.

Q: HOW WILL AN EXPANDED LIBRARY BENEFIT ME?

- · More space to hold events
- Technology upgrades
- Private meeting rooms for small or large groups
- · Study space for teens and adults

Q: WHEN WILL THE PROJECT CONSTRUCTION START?

The referendum vote is in November 2024 and if approved, the new library will start construction in 2026 with a possible move-in date of 2027.
