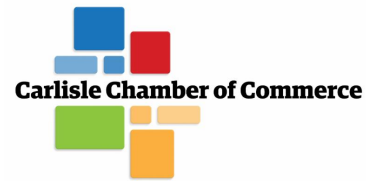

School Street Phase 3 Reconstruction

Weekly Construction Update

The intent of this weekly update is to give an overview of where construction has been, and where it should be in the next week. It is intended to be a general overview and be tentative in nature. Things may differ from the listed schedule if weather or other unknown factors come into play.



Weekly Overview: July 6th – July 17th

- City staff and Mike Killen Construction installed several water main valves along School Street and 1st Street to facilitate better shutoff procedures to ensure downtown businesses had continued water service throughout the project
- Construction started July 6 with concrete removals through the 1st Street intersection
- Mainline installed 8-inch water main pipe along School Street to 1st Street. Connections were made to the public water system at the alley in front of Sprouts and at 1st Street. A new fire hydrant was installed in the NE corner of the public parking lot across from City Hall.
- Mainline set the base for the intake along the south curb line of School Street south of City Hall. From there, storm sewer was placed (going downhill) to the east.
- Pressure testing of the new main was done and was found to pass.

What to expect next week: July 20th – July 24th

Monday-Friday

- Mainline will continue to install 8-inch water main and 24-inch storm sewer along School Street.
- Mainline will remove the sidewalk and street paving adjacent to City Hall as part of the change order approved today by Council.
- Mainline's grading subs will begin getting the subgrade (dirt) under the pavement subbase (rock) to the design grades.

What you need to know

- City Council approved a change order removing dust control as part of the original bid. This was meant to address dust at the east end of the project when the detour through the elevator property starts. City staff will be self-performing that portion of the project.
- City Council met in a special meeting and approved a change order adding sidewalk changes to address ADA compliance in front of City Hall. These were not part of the original project due to challenges with the storm water intakes, elevation concerns between the street and the entrance, and the original intent to save concrete. During construction, additional concrete was damaged and removed providing the opportunity to address the ADA access. This change will provide some challenges to accessing City Hall during this first phase of construction. Staff is working to ensure access remains as open as possible.
- City Council moved forward with changes to the alley south of School Street. Some of those changes have been made. These changes include changing it to one way and limiting parking in the alley.
 - The ordinances will be published on July 23 making it take legal effect
 - Public Works is waiting for signage to be delivered and then will install
 - Carlisle Police Department plans to start with an educational approach to dealing with violations
